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## **BYLAW NO. 1320/08**

### **A BYLAW TO FIX RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE COLLECTION, REMOVAL, AND DISPOSAL OF WASTES OR REFUSE, TO SET FEES FOR THE PROVISION OF RECYCLING SERVICES AND OPERATIONS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR TRANSFERRING ANY UNPAID ACCOUNTS TO THE TAX ROLL**

**In accordance with Part II 8(1)(i) of the Municipalities Act  
The Council of the  
Town of Gravelbourg,  
in the Province of Saskatchewan,  
enacts as follows:**

1. In this Bylaw, including this section:
  - a) “Bag and Tag Program” means the waste material collection system, established pursuant to the Town’s Waste Management Bylaw (#1081/98).
  - b) “Garbage fees” means the fee set out by the Town for the collection, removal, or disposal of solid waste or any other refuse.
  - c) “Tag” means a designated municipal tag issued by the Town for the purpose of implementing the Bag and Tag Program.
  - d) “Recycling fees” shall mean the fee set out by the Town for the provision of services by the Town or its agents established for the collection, separation, transportation and/or processing of recyclable materials deposited for recycling purposes.
  - e) “Town” means the Town of Gravelbourg.
2. The Town shall attend to collection, removal, or disposal of refuse and/or garbage from premises connected to the Town’s water and sewer service system, and the Town shall set monthly garbage fees to be paid by the owner and/or occupant of said premises as set out in accordance with “Schedule A”, attached to and forming part of this Bylaw. Said monthly garbage fees shall be payable by the owner and/or occupant whether or not refuse and/or garbage collection, removal, or disposal actually occurs in any particular month.
3. The Town shall establish sufficient deposit systems or methods for the collection of recyclable materials for use by its residents. It may also establish systems or methods of managing these materials in a manner which provides their most efficient means of handling upon sufficient quantities being collected. The Town shall set monthly recycling fees to be paid by the owner/occupant of all premises connected to the Town’s water and sewer service system as set out in “Schedule B”, attached to and forming part of this Bylaw. Said monthly recycling fees shall be payable by the owner/occupant whether or not utilized by them in any particular month.
4. Accounts for garbage and recycling fees shall cover a period of one month, and shall be rendered in conjunction with and a part of Utility Services Billing. Combined Garbage and Recycling fees shall be shown separately on the Town’s Monthly Utility Services Billing notice as “Garbage Fees”. Such accounts shall be paid within thirty days from the date the said account was rendered.

5. A penalty of 1.5% per month shall be added to garbage and recycling fees which remain unpaid thirty days after the date of billing.
6. In the case of residential garbage fees, when the owner and/or occupant pays the account fully, he/she shall receive four tags to be affixed to his/her garbage bags and/or receptacles in accordance with the Town's Waste Management Bylaw (Bylaw No.1081/98). Additional tags shall be available at the Town Office for purchase at a set price of \$2.00 each.
7. Any sum, payable to the Town for Garbage and Recycling fees, which is overdue on December 31 of the year in which the sum became payable shall be added to, and thereby form part of the taxes on the property on which the said premises are situated.
8. Bylaw No. 1082/98 is hereby repealed.
