



BYLAW NO. 1338/09

**A BYLAW TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE
USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER,
TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED BY WAY OF RENT FOR USE OF
SANITARY SEWER AND TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR
STORM SEWER SUPPLY FOR LANDS BEING DRAINED WITHIN THE
TOWN OF GRAVELBOURG**

**The Council of the
Town of Gravelbourg,
in the Province of Saskatchewan,
enacts as follows:**

1. All persons desiring to be supplied with water from the Town of Gravelbourg water supply system shall make application to the Town's Administration Office. Each application shall be accompanied by the payment of a meter deposit, for each meter, in the amount of:

-	for meters one-half inch or five-eighths inch in diameter	\$90.00
-	for meters three-quarters inch in diameter	\$130.00
-	for meters one inch in diameter	\$180.00
-	for meters over one inch in diameter	full price of the meter
2. The Town of Gravelbourg may, by bylaw, ration or limit the amount of water furnished to any or all consumers, should circumstances warrant such action.
3. If the water supply is shut off from the premises of a user, for infringement of the provisions of this Bylaw, the water supply shall not be turned on until all penalties, fees, rates, charges, and arrears, if any, have been paid.
4. Water meters shall be read quarterly (four times per year) for purposes of determining consumption of water at charges as set out in "Exhibit A" (Water Rates). Where monthly billing takes place an estimated consumption amount shall be applied to those months in which a meter is not read.
5. The charges to be paid by the water consumer, whose water service has been turned on, shall be those set out in "Exhibit A" attached to, and forming part of, this Bylaw, provided that the minimum charge shall be payable in every case, whether or not any water is consumed.
6. Persons or businesses who own or occupy premises drained, or that are by bylaw required to be drained, into the sanitary sewer shall pay, for such services, a basic monthly

service charge and any additional user fees as set out and established in “Exhibit B” attached to and forming part of, this Bylaw, provided that the basic monthly service charge shall be payable in every case where water service is turned on.

7. Persons who own or occupy premises whose land area is drained by supply of the Town’s storm sewer drainage system shall pay for such services by way of a storm drainage surcharge fee in accordance with “Exhibit C” attached to and forming part of this Bylaw provided that the surcharge shall be payable in every case where water service is turned on.
8. Accounts for water service, sewer service and storm drainage sewer charges shall cover a period of one month, and shall be rendered on, or before, the fifteenth day of the month next following such period. Accounts shall be due upon receipt. If an account is not paid within the period of thirty days, the water service may be disconnected. When the water service is disconnected, it shall not be turned on until all penalties, rates, charges, and arrears have been paid, together with a fee of \$75.00 to cover the expenses of disconnecting and reconnecting the service, provided that, if reconnection is required outside the Town of Gravelbourg employees’ regular working hours, the fee shall be \$125.00.
9. A penalty of 1.5% per month shall be added to all water and sewer accounts outstanding after thirty days from the date of billing.
10. Bylaw No. 1319/08 is hereby repealed.
11. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect December 16, 2009 subject to and upon approval thereof by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board.
