Gravelbourg, like many communities across the nation, is facing a growing housing shortage. This challenge has begun to impact not only our residents but also our local economy. Our three largest employers have all expressed difficulties in recruiting and retaining staff due to the limited availability of housing. This issue affects our entire community, as it influences our ability to attract new families, workers, and investment.

Your Town Council has made this a top priority. We have retained Associated Engineering to assist the Town in identifying suitable grants and funding opportunities to support housing development. Their work will also help us plan for continued growth, including the development of residential lands to the south and the potential transformation of the historic convent into much-needed housing units.

We are committed to working collaboratively with both the provincial and federal governments and the private sector to find solutions that will meet Gravelbourg's current and future needs.

Our goal is clear: to create the right conditions for growth, to welcome new residents, to offer families, workers, and retirees an exceptional place to call home. Together, we can ensure Gravelbourg remains a vibrant, thriving community where opportunity and quality of life go hand in hand.
