The tax notice you receive in January is a prepayment notice only, and it is based on your 2025 levy amount. Property taxes for 2026 will be levied at the end of May, and final payment is due on June 30, 2026.

When you prepay your taxes, you are eligible for a discount of up to 5% – it's our way of saying thank you for helping us stay ahead!

Sign up for equalized monthly automatic payments – no late payments, no penalty fees, just piece of mind.
