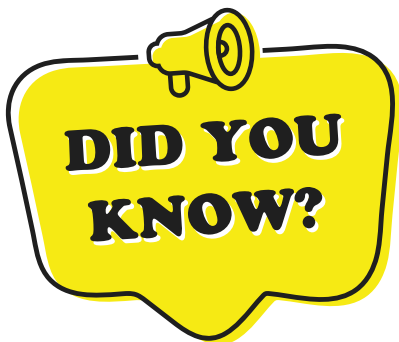

PUBLIC WORKS

PLEASE DO NOT PUT ANY WOOD IN THE COMPOST AREA!

CLEAN WOOD (from pruning etc.) can be taken to the **wood pile area on the north side of Nichol Avenue** across from the elevators. **SMALL BRANCHES** (less than 4 inches / 10cm in diameter) may be piled for chipping. **LARGE BRANCHES** (4 inches / 10cm or larger) must be put in the pit for burning.

ALL OTHER WOOD (treated, painted, etc.) can be taken to the **transfer station on Wednesdays from 11:00AM-7:00PM and Saturdays from 9:30AM-4:30PM**
