Dear Mayor & Council:

RE: **Rescinding** - Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory – Town of Gravelbourg Waterworks

Please be advised that the Water Security Agency (WSA) is rescinding the Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory (PDWA) issued to the Gravelbourg distribution system in the following locations: 1st Ave W (west of Main St.) including the 100-300 blocks and the Gravelbourg NW pipeline, 100 block of Bettez St and the 100 block of Main St, effective July 8th, 2018.

The rescinding of the PDWA was based upon information provided by your community, which included:

- Residuals are within regulated values;
- The receipt of two consecutive sets of two (4 total) bacteriological samples collected one day apart are negative for bacteriological growth in the final treated potable water.

You may return to normal monitoring requirements as identified in your permits monitoring schedule.
