Please be advised that the Water Security Agency (WSA) is rescinding the Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory (PDWA) for the users of the affected portions of the Town of Gravelbourg water system that went into effect November 2, 2018.

The bacteriological samples submitted by the town have tested negative for bacteria and the town has taken all necessary steps to ensure the safety of the water. The town should be commended for the steps they have taken to ensure the safety of their consumers. Please continue to send in the required bacteriological testing.
