### 1. **Old Court House** - 209 Main Street

The Gravelbourg Court House, influenced by Colonial styles, is one of five identical court houses built from a standard plan. The others are at Wynyard, Shaunavon, Assiniboia, and Melfort. Located along the community's Main Street, the Court House now acts as the Gravelbourg Town Office, although it is also still used for its original purpose. Built in 1926-1927, the building is now a municipal heritage property. The building is open for viewing from Monday to Friday.
